Presentation Abstract: Conventional Oil Exploration in Reefs – Shubenacadie Basin

Forent is actively pursuing an onshore exploration program on the Alton concession in central Nova Scotia. The exploration program is positioned in the Shubenacadie sub-basin targeting the Carboniferous aged reefs of the Gays River formation which are anticipated to be hydrocarbon prone in this area. Forent has used a combination of seismic, gravity gradiometry, magnetic data and existing well information to evaluate the entire Shubenacadie sub-basin and select several drilling locations.
