Dr. Robert Merrill is Vice-President and Exploration Manager of Ammonite Nova Scotia Corporation. Dr. Merrill's interest in Atlantic North America began over 35 years ago when he first started work with Cities Service Oil and Gas Corporation in 1974. At Cities, he was involved with a comprehensive analysis of the structure and stratigraphy of the North American continental shelf from Florida to Greenland. In addition to Cities Service, Bob has worked with Occidental Petroleum, Unocal and the Samson Companies exploring in North America and internationally. In 2005, Dr. Merrill formed Catheart Energy as an independent exploration and consulting company evaluating exploration opportunities, and he teaches a class on cuttings and core description. In 2008, together with G. Warfield Hobbs, he formed Ammonite Nova Scotia Corporation to pursue oil and gas opportunities offshore Nova Scotia. Dr. Merrill has a PhD and MS in Geology from Arizona State University, and a BA in Geology from Colby College. He is a Fellow of the Geological Society of America, a Chartered Geologist with the Geological Society; he has served as Secretary and President of the American Institute of Professional Geologists, and is an active member of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists.
