Biography: Mr. Allan Crandlemire, Efficiency NS

Allan Crandlemire is Chief Executive Officer of Efficiency Nova Scotia, Canada’s only independent, non-profit energy efficiency utility. Allan joined Efficiency Nova Scotia in May 2010 as interim CEO to lead the development of the new business. He was appointed CEO in July 2011.

Efficiency Nova Scotia offers services, financial incentives and straightforward advice to help Nova Scotian families, businesses and institutions save energy and money. To date we have worked with over 150,000 Nova Scotians. Energy efficiency will save Nova Scotians \$78 million in electricity costs in 2014 – savings that will continue year after year, and grow.

Efficiency Nova Scotia’s electricity efficiency services are supported by ratepayer contributions and regulated by the Utility and Review Board. Non-electric efficiency services are funded by the Province of Nova Scotia on a contract basis.

Previously, Allan served as executive director for Conserve Nova Scotia, the Province’s former energy efficiency agency. Much of his career has centred on energy policy with the provincial government.
