Biography: Dr. Greg Welch, Dalhousie University

Gregory C. Welch is an Assistant Professor of Chemistry and Canada Research Chair at Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia. He obtained a B.Sc. in Chemistry from the University of Calgary in 2003 and worked in the laboratories of Tristram Chivers and Warren E. Piers. Gregory earned his Chemistry Ph.D. at University of Windsor in 2008 under the supervision of Douglas W. Stephan. He then moved to UC-Santa Barbara, where he worked as an NSERC postdoctoral fellow with Guillermo C. Bazan in the Department of Chemistry. His research interests focus in the area of Printed Electronics, where he is developing new functional materials and sustainable/practical ways to make them.
